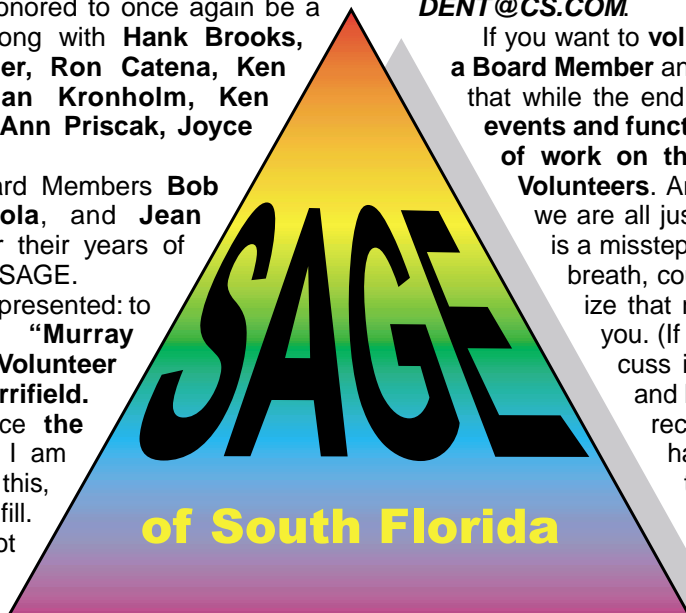

May is a good month for shaking off some of the cobwebs from the past and relaxing outdoors. This month we offer you two rather inexpensive ways to do both in the company of your SAGE family and friends.

Right before Mothers' Day, on **Saturday, May 10th**, we're going to "**Flamingo Gardens**". A tram ride has been arranged that will take us around most of the important sites (and sights) of this world famous attraction. The **25 minute tram ride is fully narrated**, as we travel through the tropical rainforest, native hammocks, wetland areas, and groves. Take your cameras, as we visit the narrated **Wildlife Encounter**, featuring native birds of prey and local reptiles. We'll also tour the **Wray House** - a national historical treasure, built in 1933 as the home of the original founders of the Gardens. There's also a **Tropical Plant House** with (special for Mothers' Day) an African Violet exhibit. And lots more to see and do.

Tour cost is \$13 for Members and \$15 for Non-Members. Lunch, snacks and sandwiches are available at the "Flamingo Cafe" overlooking the beautiful waterways where the flamingos bathe. This will be at menu price and is not included in the cost of the tour.

We will meet at the **GLCC at 10:30AM** and caravan to **Flamingo Gardens** (3750 S. Flamingo Rd., Davie, FL 33330) - or, for those coming from the south, we'll meet you at the **Front Courtyard of the Gardens at 11:30AM**.

Uh, oh! Someone goofed. (All right: Carl mixed up the movies. Instead of showing "Notes on a Scandal" this month, we showed it last month by mistake.) As a replacement movie with lots of girl-power and gay-power, the **May 19th Movie** is "**Stardust**".

Narrator (**Ian McKellen**): A philosopher once asked, "Are we human because we gaze at the stars, or do we gaze at them because we are human?" Pointless, really..."Do the stars gaze


back?" Now *\*that's\** a question.

In this 2007 movie adaptation of **Neil Gaiman's** novel, a star not only gazes down, she falls to earth, setting the stage for the rest of the Fantasy/Dramedy/Romance action that follows. "**Stardust**" follows **Tristan Thom** (a cute-becoming-handsome **Charlie Cox**) a young man on a quest to find a fallen star and bring it back to the woman he loves in order to prove his love for her. The only catch is that the star has fallen on the other side of the wall, a doorway between England and a magical kingdom known as Stormhold.

This film is a joy to watch. There's something in it for everyone. **Directed** (and **co-written with Jane Goldman**) by **Matthew Vaughn**, nothing about this film seems forced. All of the action scenes are played out beautifully; and the comedy is spread out through the film making it funny without being corny. All the performances are outstanding: The luminous **Claire Danes** makes you love her in her portrayal of Yvaine the trusting, naive star. The underrated **Michelle Pfeiffer** delivers a stellar over-the-top performance as Larnia. But *the* performance to talk about is **Robert DeNiro**...as a gay, Bronx-accented pirate. (In every scene that he is in...he chews scenery and steals the show.)

If you are in the mood for a funny, fantastical love story this is the film. And there is enough comedic-action (and dazzling special effects) to keep you entertained throughout.

Nominated for seven international film awards (including the **2008 GLAAD Media Award** nomination for Wide-Release Feature) "**Stardust**" screens (we promise) at **4PM, on Monday, May 19th at the GLCC**. 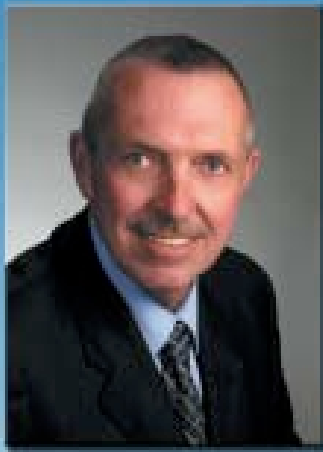
