



Arguably, the most beautiful love story ever written, William Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet* is also among the most re-interpreted of his works. But nothing quite like our January 21<sup>st</sup> movie has been attempted before. Although it was legally required in Elizabethan plays that young male actors play the female roles, it was done in a totally straightforward way: The female characters were costumed as females; the male characters treated them as the

female characters they played; and the young boys cast in the female roles were willowy and emaciated-looking. Not so in *Private Romeo*, Director/Screen Writer **Alan Brown**'s experiment in independent filmmaking. Using Shakespeare's original dialogue (in iambic pentameter) throughout most of the movie, he somehow manages to capture the universality of the story, while making it accessible to a modern-day LGBT audience.

Taking place over a single weekend at a military academy, the plot finds eight hunky, young male cadets studying the play. But it's not long until the emotions and dialogue carry over into their everyday lives. And some are forced to show their true feelings.

About her *New York Times Critics' Pick*, **Jeannette Catsoulis** wrote: "Whose curiosity wouldn't be piqued by an opportunity to see a



clutch of high school cadets re-enact Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet* as a modern-day gay tragedy?..." (Feb. 9, 2012)

Absolutely marvelous in their dual roles are **Seth Numrich** (as Sam/Romeo) and **Matt Doyle** (Glenn/Juliet) -- both from the Tony-winning *War Horse*; and **Hale Appleman** (Josh/Mercutio). Indeed, the entire theater-trained ensemble went on to win the 2011Grand Jury Award at L.A. Outfest for Outstanding Acting.

*Private Romeo* is our Valentine's gift to you...a few weeks early. It screens on Monday, January 21,

2013 at 4:15PM, in Room 204 of the Pride Center.

"Brotherhood and Love...and not about the bashing...and not about the hate....and not about the struggle. Because...I think we need more films like this...I think we need more things saying that Love is Universal...and it is beautiful, no matter what. And I'm really proud to be a part of this project." From Matt Doyle (Glenn/Juliet) on YouTube.


Since much of it is in iambic pentameter, we will be showing it with subtitles.




