LUNCH & LEARN SETUP AND BREAKDOWN VOLUNTEERS

We also have a need for other volunteers that are needed to keep the organization running smoothly. Some of you know Les Oldenbusch who has been a member of SAGE for over ten years. Les turned 92 this year and is one of our oldest members. Les has been volunteering since he first joined SAGE. He manages two important jobs for SAGE.

He is the person who stores, buys, sets up and takes away the stuff we use at our Lunch & Learns each first Saturday of the month. The storage and setup of the plates, knives, forks, spoons, napkins, table coverings, etc. are his responsibility. Because of his age he is unable to do the lifting and setup and breakdown all by himself. He will need at least one or two other volunteers to help him. The job requires coming to the Lunch & Learn site early at the Skolnick Center. The volunteers will help Les unload his car and setup the room for the Lunch & Learn. 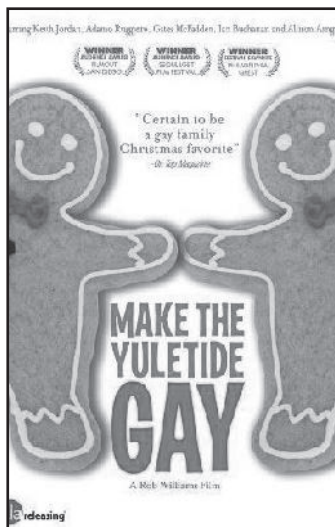

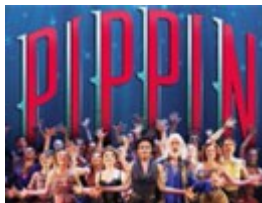
