Save The Date: Sunday, March 27th, SAGE's Annual Meeting to be held at Tropical Acres.





# SAGE BOOK DISCUSSION GROUP



Described by the *Sunday Times* as "compelling, bighearted, emotionally precise page-turner" the novel *Home Stretch* by *New York Times* best-selling writer and acclaimed British television host **Graham Norton** explores the aftermath of a tragedy on a small town to illuminate the shame and longing that

can flow through the generations - and how the secrets of the heart cannot stay buried forever.

It is 1987 and a small Irish community is preparing for a wedding. The day before the ceremony, a group of young friends, including the bride and groom, are involved in an accident. Three survive. Three are killed.

The lives of the families are shattered and the rifts between them ripple throughout the small town. Connor survived, but living among the angry and the mourning is almost as hard as carrying the shame of having been the driver. He leaves the only place he knows for another life, taking his secrets with him. Traveling first to Liverpool, then London, he eventually makes a home—of sorts—for himself in New York, where he finds shelter and the possibility of forging a new life.

But the secrets—the unspoken longings and regrets that have come to haunt those left behind— will not be silenced. Before long, Connor will have to confront his past.

A powerful novel of emigration and return, the book will be discussed by the SAGE Book Group via Zoom on Saturday, February 12 from 11 AM to 12 noon.

OK! This is not a Siskel/Ebert film review article but about two little guys on your hands. They are the first and outermost digits. These two little guys allow us to open jars, button our shirts, turn keys, and lift pans. So, when we lose these abilities through pain it becomes very problematic. Hand osteoarthritis is second only to knee arthritis for senior complaints to a specialist. Individuals over age 40 are at risk for this disease and women are affected 5 to 10 times more frequently than men.

# Signs and Symptoms

- Pain around the base of the thumb progresses over a long period of time in activities that involve gripping and pinching, causing swelling and tenderness at the base of the thumb and an aching discomfort after prolonged usage.
- There may be enlargement or a bony prominence over the joint with limited motion.

# **Diagnosis**

Your Primary Care Practitioner (PCP) will do a combination of methods and tests with a medical history, physical examination, x-rays and laboratory tests. There are many different diagnoses with thumb pain besides osteoarthritis. It can be caused by carpal tunnel syndrome (everything is connected), trigger thumb (a forthcoming article), tenosynovitis, sprains, strains or previous trauma.

#### Treatment

Non-surgical treatments (advised by your PCP) that can relieve the pain and restore function include:

- Icing the joint a few items a day for five to 15 minutes.
- Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory (NSAIDS). Check with your PCP.
- Heat packs, paraffin baths and/or many topical creams available over the counter at pharmacies.
- Hard or soft splints that immobilize the thumb.
- Steroid injections give short-term relief to about 76% of the patients.
- The University of Sidney AUS has researched and developed recently with great success a combination of non-pharmaco
  logical and pharmacological treatments

#### **Surgical Treatment**

- Ligament reconstruction and tendon interposition (LRTI) surgery. The gold standard for over 50 years. There are other procedures and your hand specialist will advise you.
- Rehabilitation, depending on the type of surgery, will have you wearing wear a cast for 4 to 8 weeks.

Thumbs are a big necessity in your daily living. So, if you have any long-standing pain, see your PCP as soon as possible. Don't suffer and have a thumb up Valentine's Day.
