Playing partners of thirteen years, **Billy Porter** stars as Gabriel, an aspiring artist struggling to find a creative and personal spark while caring for the young son he shares with his ambitious partner, Nicky (**Luke Evans**). Stress and anxiety flare as their relationship gets to an unrepairable place, forcing the couple to head for a divorce. Now the two must navigate the unenviable position of revealing the news to shared friends and family. Thus begins the journey to find themselves and

support their eight-year-old son, Owen.

Gabriel loves Owen more than anything; Nicky loves Gabriel more than anything. Their divorce leads to a custody battle that forces both of them to confront the changing reality of their love for each other and their son. It's easy to characterize this movie as being about child rearing, but it is just as much about a primary relationship that has changed while they were becoming parents. The families and the friends were warm real-life portraits of people trying to help while also being honest with people they loved. This is a deftly and delicately directed movie.

When a jock comes out as a gay to his closest friends, each of the bros has a different reaction to the big news. Will their friendship win over discrimination? This film captures the fears people have about coming out. Those conversations, the looks, the jokes, and questions, it's not something gay people look forward to going through. This movie captures the responses of straight men who learn that their 'bro' is actually gay. To all the gays in the closet, you are not obligated to come out to everyone. You can choose who to tell. It's your decision and yours alone.
